

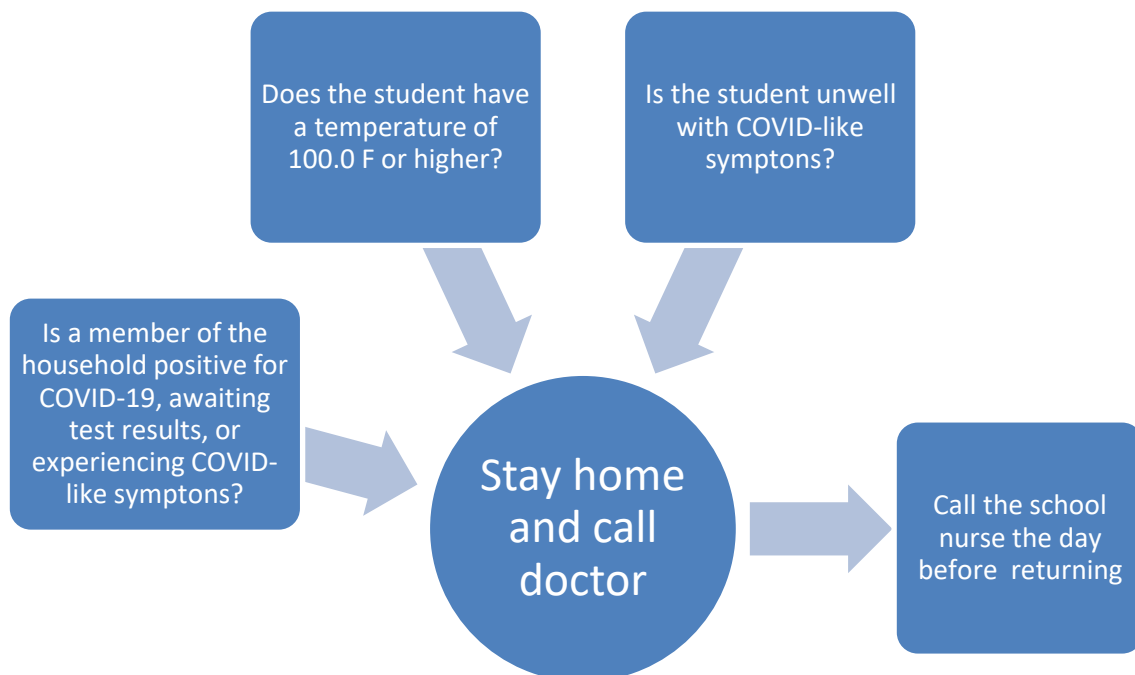
# Wyndcroft Health Guidelines:

All members of The Wyndcroft School have a shared responsibility to prevent the spread of illness. It is imperative that as a community, we remain committed to the safety procedures listed in this and future communications to help keep students, staff, and faculty safe.

Each morning, parents, staff, and faculty will complete a wellness questionnaire prior to school. Parents listed as a student's primary contact will receive a text message between 6:00 - 6:15AM with a link to submit the form each day prior to arrival.

Temperature screenings will be conducted at each entrance. Students that have a temperature of 100.0 degrees F or above will be directed to the nurse for a more accurate screening and evaluation. Parents will be contacted if a student needs to return home and must be picked up within an hour of notification.

# Wyndcroft Return to School Guidelines:

Aligned with Montgomery County Office of Public Health

If a student is home or sent home for non-COVID illness, the following return to school guidelines will be followed:

- Fever free for 24 hours without medication
- Symptom free for 24 hours without medication
- Note from physician indicating course of action
- Parents must call the school nurse the day before return

If your student is home or sent home with COVID-like symptoms, the following return to school guidelines will be followed:

- If the student receives confirmation of an alternative diagnosis from a health care provider that would explain the COVID-19-like symptoms AND
- There is no fever with out the use of fever reducing medicines for 24 hours and have felt well for 24 hours.
- Note from physician indicating course of action
- Parents must call the school nurse the day before return.

If a student is tested for COVID-19 the following guidelines will be followed:

- **If the test is negative**, they may return to school 72 hours after symptoms are no longer present.

- **If the test is positive** or a student refuses/is unable to get tested, they may return to school 10 days after isolation and 24 hours after symptoms have resolved.
- If someone tests positive in a household, they will need to isolate for 10 days, and be able to return to school or work 24 hours after symptoms have resolved. Household members will need to quarantine for 14 days AFTER the positive person's isolation is complete. The family will need to quarantine for longer than the positive person, to be sure they remain asymptomatic.
- Note from physician indicating course of action
- Parents must call the school nurse the day before return.

The Wyndcroft School is required to notify the Montgomery County Office of Public Health within 12-24 hours of notification of a positive case. It is important that parents provide testing results to the Wyndcroft School as soon as possible.

In the event that we have a positive case for COVID-19, The Wyndcroft School will follow guidance from the Montgomery County Office of Public Health and information will be shared to relevant individuals and cohorts. In addition, the faculty member or student's identity will not be communicated to the general community. In a small community, it is essential that we resist the urge to speculate remaining true to the Wyndcroft spirit of compassion and mutual respect.
